

All Age Transport Art Competition

Entrants

All are welcome to enter and display their own original artwork, to be received between Saturday 21st June and Saturday June 28th, 1pm in the post box and designated area in St Mary's church. The church will be open 10-1pm each day, except Sunday.

Art will be anonymised to make the voting as fair as possible, so please do not write your name on the front or visible.

Transport is the topic

Art Category 1*: To draw or paint an A4, landscape orientation, transport themed picture, in colour or black and white.

1a Ages 3-4; **1b** Ages 5-8; **1c** Ages 9-12; **1d** Ages 13-16; **1e** Ages 17+

Please put your contact details on a separate piece of paper and include: Your name, Category entering (e.g. 1a), DOB, Title of artwork, telephone number and email address or telephone number and email address of parent/carer if 16 or under. Please put entry and the above details in a plastic wallet and post in the box at back of St Mary's church before Sat 28th June 1pm.

Art Category 2*: To create a 3d model reflective of the transport theme, made from recyclable material. No larger than 50cm³ and no 1 dimension larger than 50cm. (Larger entries will be disqualified)

2a Under 8 years old; **2b** Ages 9-16; **2c** Ages 17+

Please put a sticker on the base of your entry to identify ownership and include Name, Category entering, DOB, Title of artwork, telephone number and email address or telephone number and email address of parent/carer if 16 or under

Judging:

Judging will be through a combination of public vote and nominated judges not connected to any entrant. Judging will be based on **creativity, uniqueness and imagination**. Judging will take place on Saturday June 28th after voting closes at 1pm.

Disqualification will arise if the size and specifications above are not followed or if the contact information above is incomplete. Remember please do not put any identifiers visible on your artwork.

Display and Voting

Artwork will be set up ready for voting on Sunday 29th June from 11.30-2.30pm, to coincide with the Soapbox Derby on Castle Street. Please come along to our BBQ, refreshments and raffle and encourage your family and friends to vote for your piece. Voting will continue all week Monday through Saturday July 5th 10-1pm

Winners will be notified on Saturday July 5th after 1pm and displayed in church during Sunday 6th July services (8am, 10.15am a Family Service and 6pm evening service).

Certificates will be awarded to all category winners and announced on St Marys with St Francis social media. Photographs of the winning art will also be used on our social media.

All artwork will be available to collect from Monday 7th July through to Saturday 12th July 10-1pm each day. Anything remaining, unless we have heard from you, will be recycled.
